Who is Eligible for the Award?

Any person employed by the Bozeman School District or schools that feed into Bozeman High School in the Special Education Department.

How do you apply for the Award?

What is the selection process?

Awards will be evaluated by Bozeman SEPTA officers and Special Education Director Chad Berg for feasibility, fit with the SEPTA Mission, and potential to make a difference in the live(s) of students with special needs. The award must be used within 12 months and the winner will be asked to write a one-page report of outcomes.

What is the deadline for submissions?
